



& related requirements in Europeana




Data & Good practices



METADATA

- **Persistent & Unique** identifiers
- Resources from **Controlled Vocabularies**
=> *Iconclass, Getty ATT & ULAN, Geoname,*
- **Language** attributes (2 letters code)
- Informational **relevance**
=> *e.g. a dimension is not a type
neither a format*
- EDM records

CONTENT

- 400px min. for thumbnails
- 800px min. for main representations
- No watermarks
- IIIF framework
- **Open licences please !**



From such URIs, the **Europeana Semantic Enrichment Framework** can **fetch the related metadata**

- translations
- broader-narrower concepts
- contextual information (e.g. profession or date of birth for agents)

Information relevance

Using the **relevant** terms / URIs references can ensure

- enhanced search result
- featuring in related Thematic Collections
 - > Migration TC with “Human-migration”
 - > Photo TC with “Photography”

But **many more** related improvements

- individual titles for records
- precise geographical data
- and so on ...

- natively compatible with Europeana




